

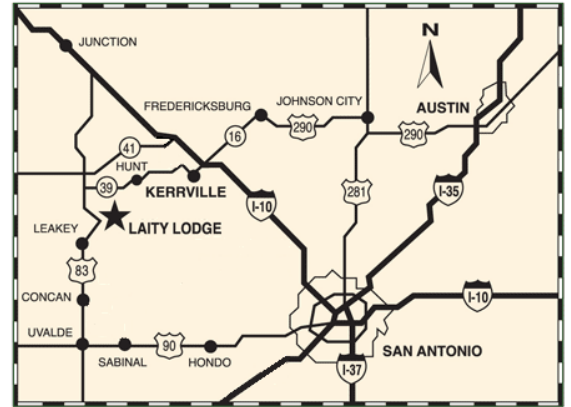
Laity Lodge

Information for Registered Guests

Thank you for your registration. The following may be helpful in your preparation:

Directions to Laity Lodge

Follow Interstate 10 to Texas Highway 41 (Exit 490). Continue West on 41 approximately 23 miles to the intersection of US Highway 83. Travel South on 83 about 15 miles to the H. E. Butt Foundation Camp gate, located on the left side of the road. A sign reading "Foundation Camps" on the right side of the road will alert you of the turn. Turn left and pass through the gate and continue travelling about 1.5 miles down a steep hill to the river road. We use the river as our road, as it has a limestone bottom and the water is only a few inches deep. Turn left into the river and remain on the left side of the markers. While driving in the river, **do not cross the stone markers**. Go about 1/3 mile to the Laity Lodge sign and turn left out of the river. Follow the main road almost a mile to the parking lot. Come down the path to the office for registration, and someone will be there to greet you.



Beginning and Ending Time

You may arrive any time after 3:00 p.m. on the first day. The scheduled activities will begin at 6:30 p.m., with the Director's Reception, followed by dinner, and the opening session beginning around 8:15 p.m. The retreat typically adjourns around noon, following brunch on the last day.

If you are planning to arrive later than 6:30 p.m. the first night or will be leaving early, please contact the Kerrville Offices at **830-792-1230** or the Host/Hostess at the Lodge at **830-258-5640**.

What to Bring

Please dress comfortably. The atmosphere at Laity Lodge is very informal, so casual or sport clothes are appropriate. Pack appropriate footwear for your involvement in any of the many recreational activities available, including hiking, tennis, and biking. Be sure to include any personal toiletries and a hair dryer if you need one. Towels, bedding, housekeeping service, and laundry facilities are provided.

Children

We request that guests do not bring children to retreats.

Pets

We request that guests do not bring pets to retreats as there are no facilities to house animals. Any guest that requires the assistance of a service animal, or any animal that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, is welcome to bring such animal.

Information for Registered Guests

Upon arrival at Laity Lodge, please register with the host/hostess to receive the location of your accommodations. Coffee, tea, and fruit are available in the dining room for your refreshment. A bell will announce mealtime and meetings.

Facilities

All rooms are double occupancy with primarily twin beds and private baths. Room keys are not provided, so DO NOT lock the door when you leave your room. If you do happen to lock your door, a key is available in the office. If anything requires maintenance attention, please tell the Host/Hostess or leave a note in the office. A soft drink machine is located next to the laundry facilities, up the set of stairs behind the bookstore. The ice machine is located under the first stairway to the Lodge, and ice buckets are available from the kitchen staff.

Meals

A bell ring will announce mealtimes. Healthful and delicious meals are prepared and served by our staff. Breakfast is typically served at 8:30 a.m., lunch at 1:00 p.m., and supper at 6:30 p.m. On the last day, brunch will be served at 11:00 a.m. ***Please report food allergies and other special dietary needs at least two weeks before the retreat.***

If needed, personal essentials are available for purchase in the Office.

Public phones are available outside the dining room if you need to make an outgoing call. Calling cards are required and are available for purchase in the Office. Cellular phones will not pick up service at Laity Lodge.
